



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Entries to be submitted by 4th June 2018

1. The John Bunyan Museum writing competition is organised by the John Bunyan Museum & Library Committee, Bunyan Meeting, Bedford.
 2. The competition is open to all school age children and young people 5-16 years.
 3. One entry per person.
 4. Work should be submitted on A4 paper.
 5. All entries must be the sole work of the writer and unpublished at the time of submission to the competition.
 6. The judges will be nominated by the John Bunyan Museum & Library Committee.
 7. Judging of the competition will be completed by 4th July 2018. Winners/schools will be contacted and named for each age group. Prizes will be awarded for each age group and the work included in a display. The John Bunyan Museum & Library Committee reserves the right not to award any or all of the prizes.
 8. Copyright of the winning entries will rest with the writer. However entry into the competition will permit unrestricted, uncredited use of the material by the John Bunyan Museum & Library for promotional purposes.
 9. All competition entries must be received by Cherry Protheroe, Bunyan Meeting, Mill Street, Bedford on Monday 4th June 2018. Entries can be received anytime up to that date and must be clearly marked Writing Competition.
 10. John Bunyan Museum does not accept liability for the loss of or damage to any entries. Proof of posting is not proof of delivery.
 11. John Bunyan Museum are unable to return any newspaper articles submitted for this competition to individuals; however entries will be returned to schools, or will be available for collection up to one calendar month after the winners have been announced.
